### COSTUME COLLECTION

All costumes will be available for collection from studio 1 in the first week of term 4. Parents must sign for costumes and therefore, they may not be collected by children. Please note that costumes may not be collected unless you are up to date with payments for both your costumes, and term 3 fees. All costumes must be collected by Friday, 16 October. Clear costume bags will be on sale at collection for \$15 per bag, or 2 for \$25

So that all students have the same coloured tights on stage, we request that tights be purchased from the in house dance shop (\$15). It is also vital that students have the correct coloured shoes for concert. This means that students who own tan jazz or tap shoes will need to a) purchase black shoes or b) paint their shoes. Shoe paint can be purchased from all good dance and shoe repair stores. All items above can be purchase in house, bar tap shoes and canvas shoes, the later of which are sold at kmart and big w.

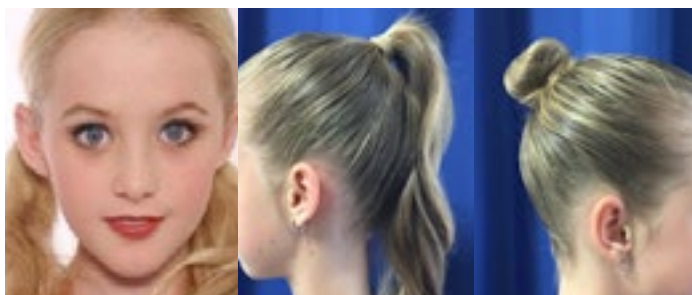
## HAIR AND MAKEUP FOR CONCERT, CONCERT REHEARSAL AND PHOTO DAY

### HAIR REQUIREMENTS

For photo day, rehearsal and concert, hair needs to be kept as tight and neat as possible, with all fly aways secured with hair spray and bob-by pins. Pony tails need to be high, meaning they follow the child's smile line and sit on the crown of the head as shown. Children who do both ballet and other styles will need to change their hair from a high pony tail to a bun for ballet. For buns, we recommend securing with bun pins and a bun net that matches the childs hair colour (bun kits sold in house). All hair and makeup must be done prior to your arrival at photo day, rehearsal and concert. However, It should be noted for any children with allergies, that products including hair spray and deodorant will be being used in the back room.

## DANCE SHOP:

Please note that the dance shop will not be open on photo day. Please ensure that you are prepared, with all costumes, tights, shoes and other necessary items having been picked up in the weeks prior to the day.

## CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION:

Unfortunately, as we use some photos taken on photo day for our website and advertising, children without the correct hair, make up, footwear and legwear may not be photographed in group photos. For the same reason, if you have not given permission on your enrolment form for photos to be taken of your child, your child is not permitted to participate in group photos, or the filming of the end of year video.

**WHEN: Saturday 17 October 2015**

**WHERE: Payne Rd State School, Studio 1**

## WHAT HAPPENS:

Photo day is an opportunity for your children to have their photos taken by a professional photographer in their concert costumes. It is also the day we film our music video, to be shown at the end of year concert and put on the concert DVD. Participation in the day is free, with no obligation to purchase photos.

## GETTING THERE:

As with last year, photos will take place in the main dance studio (studio 1). Parking is available in the usual spot!

## ARRIVAL AND RUNNING OF THE DAY:

As we are running on a very tight schedule for photo day, we request that children arrive at least 15 minutes prior to the photo time allocated to their class. Children should arrive with correct hair and makeup done (see previous page). Your child should be dressed exactly as they would be for concert. Please check that you have all costume pieces, correct shoes and correct tights with you before you leave home.

## A REQUEST FOR PARENTS:

To help the day run on time, we request that all parents wait outside the room for your children to finish. We will have a parent waiting area set up outside the hall with chairs, tables and a marque. We are also having a coffee van come for the day, so bring some change if you would like to take advantage of this! Taking photos on your own devices, in front of the photographer's backdrop, is not permitted, out of respect for the photographer.

Children who have one time slot directly after another may bring their costumes with them to get changed in the hall between shoots. For all other children, the toilets will be open.

## PHOTO/ DVD ORDERS AND COLLECTION:

You will be notified on our facebook page when photos are available for viewing and ordering. You may view photos on any dance afternoon at the studio. Order forms will be available from the dance studio. Payment (in cash or direct deposit) must accompany this form upon its return.

Concert DVD order forms will also be available in the lead up to concert. DVDs include concert footage and the photo day video.

Photo orders will be available for collection from Monday 16 November. Those who order DVDs will be notified via text message or email when these are ready for collection. Please see page 1 for final dates to hand forms in.

# CONCERT DRESS REHEARSAL (Compulsory)

### ARRIVAL:

Your child must arrive with correct hair and makeup done (see page 1), in the first costume they will be dancing in, with all other costumes in order, waiting and ready to dance.

We will be running through each half twice. Children dancing in only one half will not be required to stay for rehearsal time allocated to the half they are not dancing in. However, all cast members must be at finale rehearsal.

### SIGNING IN AND OUT:

Upon arrival, children **MUST** be signed in at the sign in desk by a parent or guardian. The desk will be located at the entry to the hallway leading to the dressing rooms, as it was last year. Children should be signed in when they arrive and signed out when you collect them. This is vital in assisting us to properly exercise our duty of care, as we need to be able to account for every child.

### WHICH DRESSING ROOM IS MY CHILD IN?:

Dressing rooms will be well signed, but are allocated as follows:

**11-12 years and 13+ years:** Classroom on the left side of the hallway

**9-10 years:** Side corner of the back room

**All other age groups:** Back room. Please place your bags around the sides of the room, under the sign allocated to your age group.

### EXTRA REHEARSAL TIMES:

Students in **yellow highlighted** classes will be required to stay from 6:00pm - 7:00pm for the 11-12 years extra rehearsal.

Students in **pink highlighted** classes will be required to stay from 7:00pm - 8:30pm for the senior's extra rehearsal.

Extra rehearsals are to allow for routines to be properly placed on stage. These rehearsals are compulsory. However, students are not required to be in costume and may wear a show dance shirt and comfortable dance bottoms, with correct footwear for each dance. Students participating in these rehearsals should meet in the audience of the auditorium, with everything they need for the rehearsal as soon as the 2nd run through of the 2nd half is complete (6:00pm).

If you have children in other age groups, these children will need to be picked up at their specified times. They are not permitted to stay backstage during extra rehearsals as there will be no supervision, and they may not watch in the audience of the rehearsal as we wish to minimise noise.

# REHEARSAL (cont.) and CONCERT

## QUICK CHANGE:

All students who are to be in the quick change room will be informed prior to rehearsal day. No other students, or parents, are permitted in the quick change room at any time.

## PARENTAL INVOLVEMENT:

We request that all parents are considerate of the fact that this year, the back rooms will be filled to capacity with students. Parents will not be permitted back stage. Back rooms will be well supervised by staff during both rehearsal and concert. Children are to be dropped off after being signed in.

Parents who do not have a child in the quick change room, are not permitted in the quick change room or in the wings. This became a particular problem last year, with some students missing cues as they were unable to get past parents crowding the space between quick change and the stage. We are so excited to share our hard work with you, but viewing of the show should be reserved for concert, not for rehearsal day.

## HOW TO MAKE THE DAY RUN SMOOTHLY:

- Arrive on time
- Have all costume items named, and ready to go
- Do all hair and makeup before you arrive.
- If you need to change between numbers, keep ALL personal items together and keep costumes bagged
- Bring plenty of water and snacks

## NO CANTEEN:

There will be no canteen or kitchen access at rehearsal day this year. However, we will be having a coffee van! Please ensure your children have eaten lunch prior to arrival, and are packed with snacks and water to keep them going throughout the day.

## LASTLY, A BIG THANKYOU!

*On a final note, we know that rehearsal day is a huge day for kids, who get very tired! However, we want to thank our wonderful parents in advance for letting us wear them out for two days out of the year so that we can put on a wonderful show! We couldn't do this without your support!*

# CONCERT!

**WHEN:** Saturday 21 November (11:30am and 6:00pm)

**WHERE:** Stuartholme, Joigny Auditorium

As with last year, we are having two shows on concert day. Children are required to perform in both shows, except for the following classes, who will **only perform in the day show**:

- 3-4 Tiny Toes: *Polar Express*
- 5-6 Ballet: *April Showers*
- 5-6 Jazz: *Locomotion*

## TICKET SALES:

Tickets will be available for purchase at rehearsal and at the dance studio, every week day afternoon from Friday, 16 October. Tickets are \$16.50 for children (up to grade 12), \$22.00 for adults and free for children 3 years and under (provided they sit on an adult's lap). These can be paid for via cash or bank transfer. Seats are allocated on a first come first served basis. Please note that we are expecting to sell out this year, and cannot fill the auditorium past capacity, so we advise parents to get in quick! We cannot reserve tickets without payment. **NO TICKETS WILL BE SOLD AT THE DOOR.**

## ARRIVAL AND SHOW TIMES:

**Show times this year are:** 11:30am and 6:00pm

**Performers MUST arrive by:** 10:45am and 5:15pm

All performers should arrive in their first costume, with hair and makeup done, ready to dance.

Doors open for audience members half an hour before the start of each show.

## PERFORMERS ONLY IN ONE HALF:

Performers who are only in one half of the concert will be brought into specially allocated, staff supervised seating to watch the show.

## SIGN IN AND OUT/ BETWEEN SHOWS:

As with rehearsal, children must be signed in and out of the auditorium by a parent or guardian for each show.

Children must be picked up after each show and are not permitted to remain at Stuartholme between shows. No supervision will be provided between shows, and this goes against our duty of care. Performers are also responsible for taking their personal items, costumes and rubbish with them at the completion of each show. Show Dance takes no responsibility for items that are lost, or stolen between shows, and all lost property will be donated to charity at the conclusion of the event.

The day show is expected to finish at 2:15pm.

The night show is expected to finish at 8:45pm.

## PARKING:

Parking this year will be primarily on the Stuartholme oval on Concert day. This has been opened up as there is a waterpolo tournament on at the college on the same day. Upon arrival, cars from Show Dance will be ushered to allocated parking. It is advisable that you arrive in good time, and have a Show Dance sticker on your car for ease of identification. These will be given out, free of charge, with the purchase of your tickets.

## CANTEEN:

We will have a cash only canteen running on concert day, with snacks, drinks and coffee available for purchase. Food may not be taken into the auditorium. Please bring small change - nothing is over \$2.00
